Porterbrook clinic offers courses that provide a comprehensive training programme in psychosexual health that incorporates sexual health, medicine and therapeutic approaches.

Our courses offer truly integrative approaches, and are approved by the British Association of Sexual and Relationship Therapy (BASRT).

## Courses

The courses on offer provide health professionals with an opportunity to acquire specialist understanding and qualifications in sexual and relationship assessment, treatment and referral skills. In addition, these courses provide a platform for further specialist study and career progression through continued professional development.

The Courses:

- Address the key factors in a mind/body approach to the evaluation, diagnosis and treatment of sexual function complaints
- Provide practical understanding about sexual dysfunctions and how to assess them
- Support an increased level of comfort and facility to incorporate sexual medicine into existing practice.
- Explore current cutting edge treatment strategies for sexual dysfunction.

Porterbrook Clinic is part of the NHS Sheffield Care Trust and provides clinical, training and research services, working with National and European sexual medicine and psychotherapy organisations.
